The Gift of Fear

Leader: The gift of Fear fills us with a sovereign respect for God, and makes us dread nothing so much as to offend Him by sin. It is a fear that arises, not from the thought of hell, but from sentiments of reverence and filial submission to our heavenly Father. It is the fear

that is the beginning of wisdom, detaching us from worldly pleasures that could in any way separate us from God. "They that fear the Lord will prepare their hearts, and in His sight will sanctify their souls." Let us Pray:

All: Grant me the Spirit of Wisdom that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal.

Leader: Grant me the Spirit of Understanding to enlighten my mind with the light of Your divine truth.

All: Grant me the Spirit of Counsel that I may ever choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining heaven.

Leader: Grant me the Spirit of Fortitude that I may bear my cross with You and that I may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose my salvation.

All: Grant me the Spirit of Knowledge that I may know God and know myself and grow perfect in the science of the Saints.

Leader: Grant me the Spirit of Piety that I may find the service of God sweet and amiable.

All: Grant me the Spirit of Fear that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread in any way to displease Him.

INTERCESSION DAY 2

C: Let us pray to our Father who through His Son Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to His Apostles:

6. For you and I, that with genuine fear of the Lord in our hearts we may have true reverence for God and detest evil in all its forms and so overcome sin in our lives. Let us pray to the Lord.

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

All: Christ Jesus, before returning to your Father in heaven, you promised to send your Holy Spirit on your disciples. We are your disciples today - Pour out your Spirit into our lives so that we may reflect your grace and love and in this way, spread your Gospel to those whom we meet. Jesus and looking at His Five Wounds and trusting in His **Precious Blood and adoring His** opened Side and stricken Heart I implore You Adorable Spirit Helper of my infirmity, so to keep me in your grace that I may never sin against You. Give

me grace O Holy Spirit, Spirit of the Father and the Son to say to you always and everywhere "Speak Lord for Your servant hears." AMEN.
