REFLECTION: The Call to be United

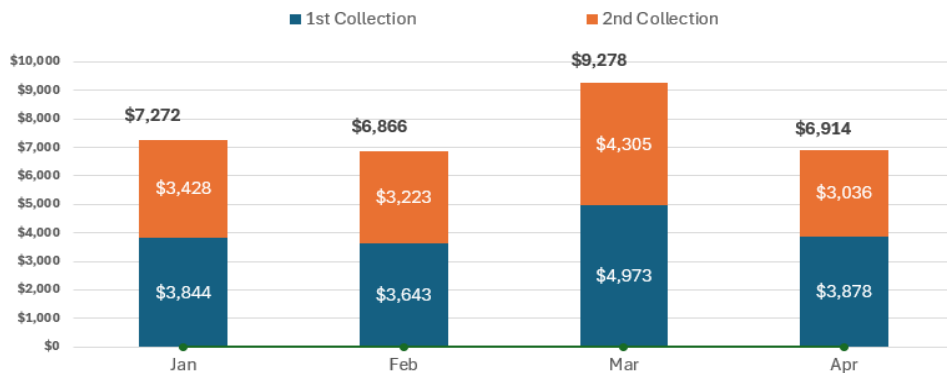
In today's first reading, we see the disciples returning to Jerusalem after witnessing Jesus' ascension. They gather in the upper room, united in prayer. Their unity is not just a superficial display but a deep and sustained companionship as they share their anxieties, hopes and moments of prayer. The image of the disciples alongside Mary in the upper room shows the essence of unity. It is the daily commitment of each individual to be present for one another and to support one another through prayer.

In the Gospel, Jesus' prayer centres on oneness, oneness between Himself and His Father, and between Himself and the disciples. He prays that the disciples stay united just as He is united with the Father, so that the world may witness the Father's love. Unity is shown not just as getting along well with others, but as a deep connection rooted in a shared life with God. Today, we are called to work for true unity with those around us. However, to achieve this, we must first be united with Jesus so that we can be united with others.

Reflective question:

How can I build deeper relationships and stay united with others?
