### REFLECTION: Receive the Holy Spirit

On the first Easter evening, the Risen Jesus appears to His scared disciples, who are hiding behind locked doors. He greets them with peace and breathes on them, saying, “Receive the Holy Spirit.” He then gives them the power to forgive sins. When Jesus breathes on the disciples, it shows that He is not far away but is present, renewing their relationship and rebuilding the community. With the Holy Spirit dwelling in them, the disciples receive peace in place of fear, steadied by the presence of the risen Christ. No longer merely followers, they are now renewed people with a mission to share the gospel, forgive and restore sinners and bear faithful witness.

On this Pentecost Sunday, may the Holy Spirit reshape and transform us. When we receive the peace of Christ we become vessels of His peace by offering words and actions of forgiveness in our families, neighbourhoods, parishes, and workplaces. The Spirit empowers everyday people like us, to extend peace and reconciliation into every aspect of daily life.

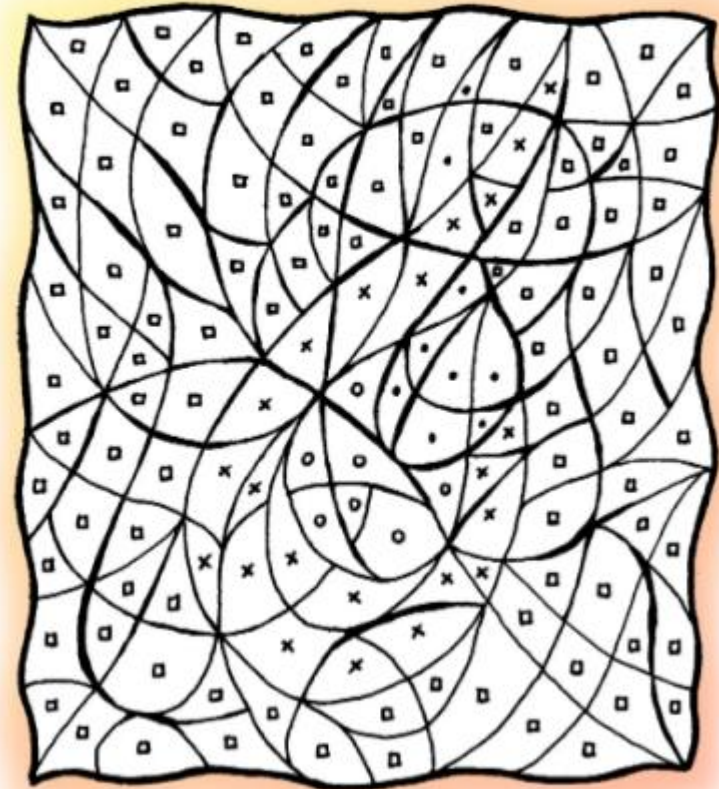
### **VYD 2026 Host / Foster Families (5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> June)**
