ELEVENTH SUNDAY, ORDINARY TIME 'A'

FIRST READING

Exodus 19: 2-6

Covenants or relationships between kings or rulers and people were common in biblical times. This covenant, however, is unusual because God takes the initiative to call a people into a unique and intimate relationship. God not only speak through Moses to the people, but also challenges Israel to respond to this invitation in obedience to God's commands. Because of its unique covenant relationship. Israel becomes a kingdom of priests, a holy nation. This desert experience and encounter with God is the heart of Israel's call as a people.

SECOND READING

Romans 5: 6-11

Paul reminds the Roman community that God reconciled us through the death of Christ. The freedom and fidelity of God calls us into a unique relationship at a time when humanity is in dire need of salvation. The reconciling action of God in Christ brings us peace and harmony through the Spirit of Christ. Paul's insight into God's initiative in manifesting reconciling love sets the tone for his teaching on Christian life.

GOSPEL

Matthew 9: 36 - 10: 8

Jesus summons the twelve disciples and gives them the authority and the power to minister as he does, curing those who are in need. Jesus takes the initiative in the call of his followers, and the apostles, a term used only here in Matthew, receive a direct mandate regarding their mission from him. The mission of the disciples is narrowly defined as proclamation to the lost sheep of Israel. As disciples proclaim the kingdom of God, they echo Jesus' own preaching, and their healings reflect his concern for those in need.
